Andrew and his colleagues were disappointed when the decision was made not to progress the bypass (see for information the press release below issued by his colleague Natasha Asghar MS). You've asked for our thoughts, ideas and experience - most of Andrew's cases regarding traffic relate to requests for slower speeds, so items such as speed bumps, driver feedback signs, 20mph zones, road narrowings etc - that can help with the speed of traffic but I appreciate not the volume of vehicles in Llanbedr. One document that I came across a few years ago was published by Dorset AONB - Traffic in villages. It is a few years old now and is based on policies at the time in England, but it might have a few ideas which could help. Also there are a lot of links. It can be found online at: Dorset-Villages-Traffic-Calmng.pdf (godalming-tc.gov.uk) I must just advise that we can't get involve in the specifics as Llanbedr is outside Andrew's South Wales Central region, however if you have any general ideas you want to informally run past us then that's not a problem.
